



I AİMS

Due to the circumstances brought about by the pandemic, the 2020 edition of the Digital Photography contest aims to contribute to changing how we relate to the sea and others. It also aims to encourage changes to be made in our use of the beach, as well as our social and environmental behaviours, while always valuing the natural heritage that surrounds us and seeking to stimulate the creativity of those who dedicate themselves to the pleasure of capturing images.

2. THEME "BACK TO THE SEA, WITH A NEW ATTITUDE."

For this year's edition, the theme suggested by the European Blue Flag Association "Back to the sea, with a new attitude" calls for images that testify to a new approach to looking at and enjoying beaches and the sea. With a basis on the care that should be taken over maintaining safe distances and implementing individual protective measures during the pandemic, a focus is also placed on the ongoing need to protect our ocean environments. And these actions are not limited to behaviours while on the beach; everything we do at home, at school, at work, and while we're out and about makes a difference, which means that every day, we can work to protect the sea according by following the motto "The Sea Starts Here, The Sea Starts with You!". All photos must be taken within the municipality of Lagos.

3. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

3.1 – Applicants must be aged 14 or over. Members of the organisation who are involved in the event may not apply.

3.2 – Applicants may enter a maximum of THREE (3) photos. Only jpg/jpeg files will be accepted, of which the longest side must have least 1,200 pixels and which are no larger than 3Mb (Note: the email system used does not support messages larger than 10Mb). The name of the digital file should include the title of the photo, the location where the photo was taken and the name of the artist, for example: "Reflections - Batata Beach-José Silva". All images must be accompanied by a description containing no more than 1500 characters and must relate to the theme of the competition.

3.4 — İn addition to their personal data, competitors aged under 18 must also provide their guardian's personal data (as per the previous point), who will be held responsible for the content of the photos entered by the competitor.

3.5 — Photos can be entered as of the 1st August 2020, and the deadline for entries is the 30th September 2020.

3.6 - Competition organisers shall not be held responsible for any damage to or loss of work, or any lacking email communications.

3.7 - By submitting an entry to the email address provided, applicants attest to having read and accepted the conditions established in this regulation.

4. JURY

4.1 - The competition Jury is made up of the Municipality of Lagos' Environment and Culture services employees and quest photographers. It will be chaired by a member of the municipality's executive committee.

4.2 – The Jury will meet before the end of October and decide on the winners, whose names will be announced publicly.

4.3 - The Jury may choose not to award any prizes if they believe the quality of photos entered into the competition is

not up to standard. 4.4- The decisions made by the jury may not be appealed.

5. PUBLISHING OF RESULTS

5.1 – The results will be displayed on the Municipality of Lagos' website: https://www.cm-lagos.pt/ and on the "Município de Lagos" Facebook page: https://www.facebook.com/ camaramunic-ipaldelagos, as of the 30th October 2020.

5.2 – Winners will be informed by email on or after 30th October 2020.

6 PRİZES

6.1 – Lagos (ity Council will award the following cash prizes:

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6.2 — The date, time and location in which the prizes shall be awarded will be announced in due course.

7.1 — Upon entering the competition, participants grant the Municipality of Lagos permission to exhibit their work. Competition winners also authorise their work to be shared and reproduced in publications and other promotional material. The (ity Council commits to crediting the artist of any photos used, though the artist shall not be entitled to any financial, or other, compensation for this use.

7.2 – Entrants are held responsible by the Municipality of Lagos for complying with copyright and intellectual property laws on the photographs entered. Entrants further declare that the act of sharing or printing of their photos will not harm or infringe upon the rights of any third parties.

8. PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

8.1 — The operations used to process applicants' personal date rely on data subjects expressly providing their consent. Data subjects may do so by providing the express desire for their data to be processed, or, in the event of the data subject being a minor, their legal guardians providing consent. Data is processed exclusively for the purposes set out in the "Back to the sea, with a new attitude" Photography Competition Regulations.

7. AUTHORISATION OF THIRD-PARTY USAGE

8.2 - Personal data processing operations are carried out in accordance with the terms of this regulation, as well as the terms of the Data Processing Information Sheet in the "Back to the sea, with a new attitude" Photo Competition and the terms of the Data Protection Policy, which can be accessed at any Service Desk in the Municipality of Lagos or at www.cm-lagos.pt.

8.3 – Data subjects may request information, submit complaints or exercise their data protection rights, specifically the right to be informed, of access, to consultation, to rectification, to opposition, to limit the processing of their personal data and of erasure. Data subjects may also withdraw their consent by contacting the Data Protection Officer, either in person, at a Municipal Service Desk or by email at protecaodedados@cm-lagos.pt, within regular opening hours.

9 FINAL PROVISIONS

9.1 – Any omissions in this regulation will be dealt with by the organisation, the only entity with the authority to do so.

9.2 — By entering this competition, participants implicitly agree to the terms of this regulation.
